Regulations

1. The total credits required for graduation are 30 credits (comprising 3 required credits, 21 elective credits, and 6 thesis credits).
2. Credits per semester: First-year students may register for 6-16 credits in their first semester; all other semesters allow 3-16 credits.
3. Students must either complete the academic ethics course offered by the Taiwan Academic Ethics Education Resources Center and obtain a certificate of completion, or attend at least 6 hours of academic ethics-related workshops and obtain a certificate of participation. When applying for the master's thesis oral examination, students must submit one of the aforementioned certificates; only upon review and approval may the application for the oral examination proceed.
4. Graduate students, based on their research needs, may take up to 3 credits of courses each semester related to their professional field in other departments or graduate institutes within the university or other universities. These credits may be recognized toward graduation requirements, with a maximum limit of 6 credits in total
5. For students admitted to the master's program under Article 7 of the 'Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Levels for Admission to Universities,' the department will assign professional faculty to provide curriculum consultation and guidance. However, such guidance/courses shall not be counted toward graduation credits.
6. Course titles are appended with the suffix (AI) to indicate that AI-related knowledge and skills are incorporated into the curriculum.
